Recommended leisure spots along the Anabuki River

Anabuki River - Cleanest River of Shikoku Every year The Shikoku Regional Development Bureau tests the water quality of twenty-one "Class-1" (nationally maintained) rivers in Shikoku, after which it publishes the test results. According to their findings, the Anabuki River has the lowest average BOD values (Biochemical Oxygen Demand = criterion for measuring organic pollution) of all of these rivers and is therefore called the "Cleanest River of Shikoku". The Anabuki River has its origins in Mt. Tsurugi in Koyadaira (Mima City, Tokushima Prefecture), from where it runs through Anabuki-cho to finally join up with the Yoshino River. In summer this river is crowded with people since it has some of the best river leisure spots of Tokushima Prefecture.

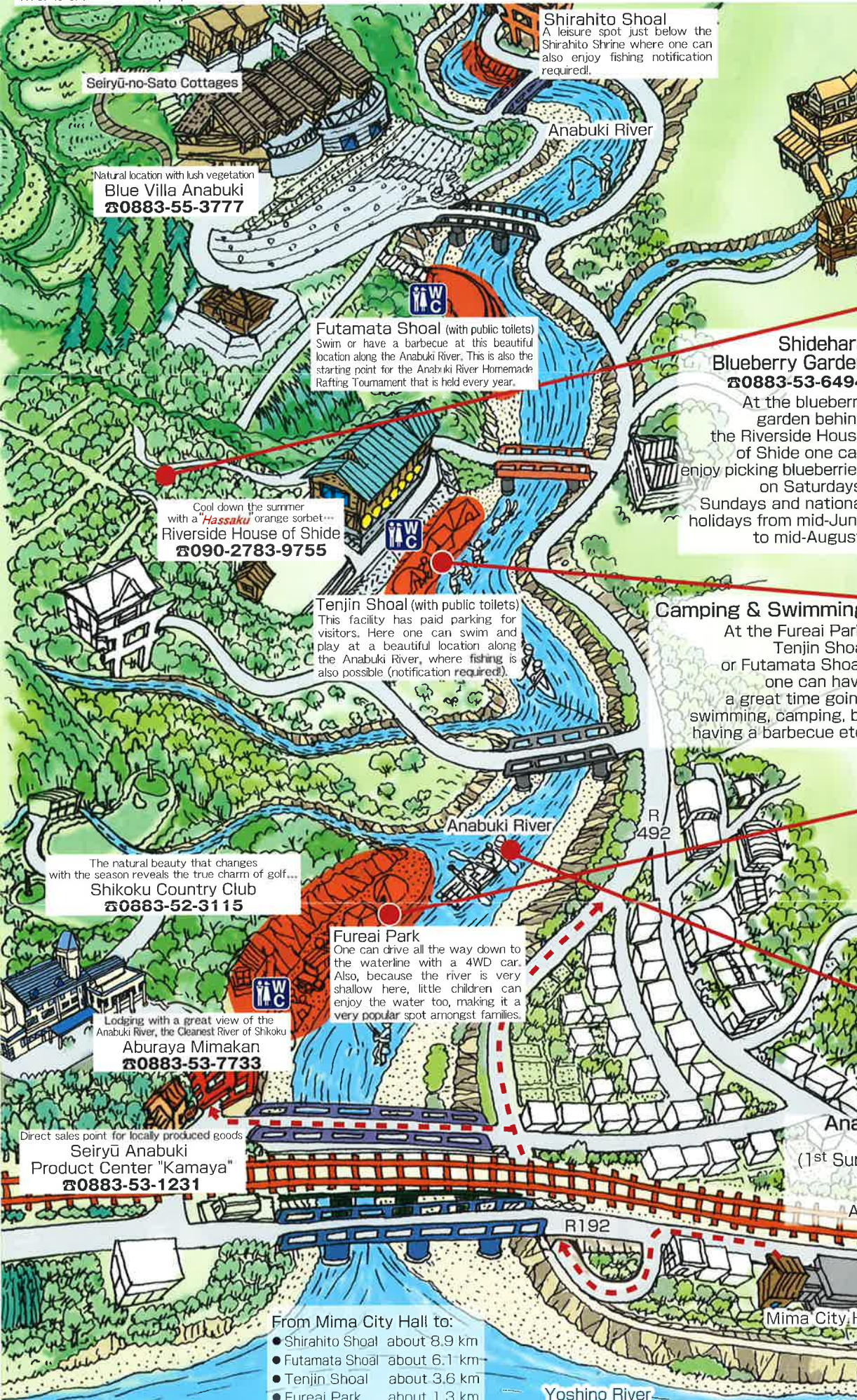
At the blueberry garden behind the Riverside House of Shide one can enjoy picking blueberries on Saturdays, Sundays and national holidays from mid-June to mid-August.
